- ✓ If staff or pupils discover unsuitable sites the URL (address), time and content shall be reported to the teacher who will then report to the Head-teacher, by recording the incident in an e-safety log, which will be stored in the School Office with other safeguarding materials. The e-safety log will be reviewed termly by the e-safety co-ordinator.
