### Governors' Annual Sponsored Walk

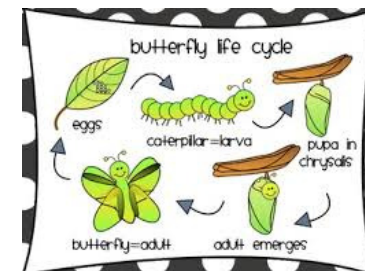
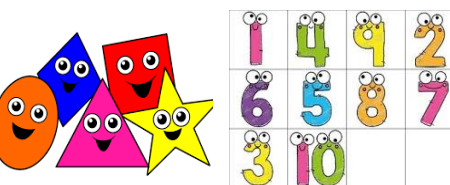

### Christian Value

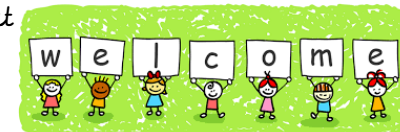
