Exemplar Education Slips

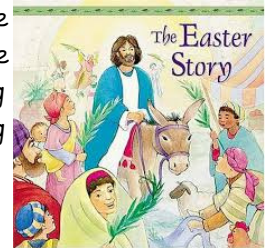
