Yr2 children need a warm coat, hat, scarf, gloves and AT LEAST two layers of clothing for Forest School Days.

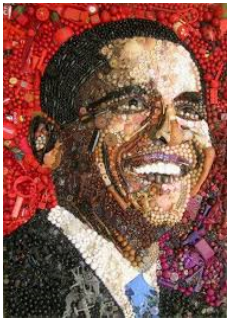


'Good to be Green' Project Afternoon
